



## **Job Title: Service Technician (Fryer Oil Specialty)**

### **\$13.00 Per Hour Starting Rate**

**JOB DESCRIPTION** (this position is with a mobile van-based Black-owned franchise business)

The basic function of the Service Technician is to provide onsite filtration of cooking oil and the deep cleaning of commercial fryers located in hospitals, colleges, stadiums and other commercial kitchens. After completion of the initial training, the Service Technician will know how to safely and efficiently operate our Mobile Filtration Unit (MFU) and how to efficiently deep clean commercial fryers. After the initial training the Service Technician is assigned specific client accounts that he/she will service independently. While this is our primary service the Service Technician may be introduced to and trained on other service offerings.

### **ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS**

- Actively participate in, and successfully complete entire training process and demonstrate required proficiencies and maintenance of the Mobile Filtration Unit (MFU)
- Keep van clean, stocked and well organized
- Utilizes provided safety equipment and exercise good safety practices at all times.
- Follow the provided schedule each week and be timely for appointments.
- Clean up spills immediately and keep a clean work area
- Advise Kitchen staff and management as well as supervisor of any potential safety issues.
- Provide friendly, high-quality customer service.
- Correctly complete and submit daily service receipts, condition reports and other records as directed with care and integrity
- Service assigned accounts within the specified period of time

### **EDUCATION & EXPERIENCE**

- High school diploma or equivalency credential required; and kitchen/food service experience preferred

### **ADDITIONAL REQUIREMENTS**

- Be at least 25 years of age (this is the minimum age required for insurance coverages)
- You must have a valid driver's license and good driving history
- **You must be able to immediately pass a drug and alcohol test**
- You must be able to routinely lift and push up to 75 pounds
- **You must have open availability to work day, night and weekend shifts** (per client contracts)
- Per client contract, there may be opportunities for new assignments related to drain clean-outs and the installation of panels in walk-in refrigerators; training will be provided for these assignments
- You must have reliable transportation to and from the main base of operation in Philadelphia
  - public transportation is not considered a reliable method given base work location and work shifts
- You must have a mobile phone that can send and receive text messages and be able to use a Smartphone
